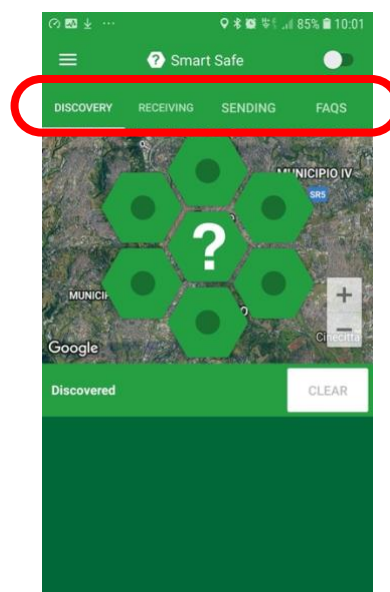

1. Homepage

Once you have launched the app, our homepage will appear where you will see a menu bar that reads: 'DISCOVERY', 'RECEIVING', 'SENDING' and 'FAQS'.



2. Enter your information

Next, click on the 'SENDING' button on the menu bar.

Here, you can enter your information such as:

- Name
- Illness name
- Date last diagnosed positive
- Date last diagnosed clear
- Date last had symptoms
- Mobile number
- Email
- Any other important notes

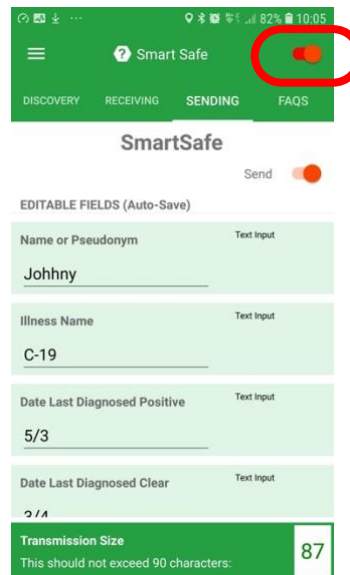

3. Turn on your location and reveal your health status

Once you have entered your information, activate the Discovery Service by tapping the button on the top right-hand corner of the page.

Once switched on, it will turn red and sound an alert activation noise.

This will then reveal your location to those around you and update them on your health information.

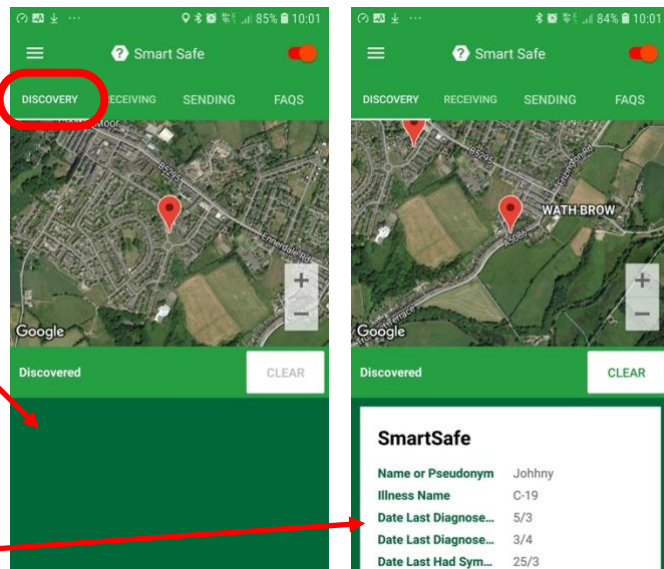


4. View others around you

Next, click the 'DISCOVERY' button on menu, you will then be taken back to the homepage where you will see a map which pinpoints those around you.

Below the map in the green box, a list of names will appear. This is a list of people that the app has identified around you.

After selecting a person you are able to see the individuals' health status, as inputted by them in the app.

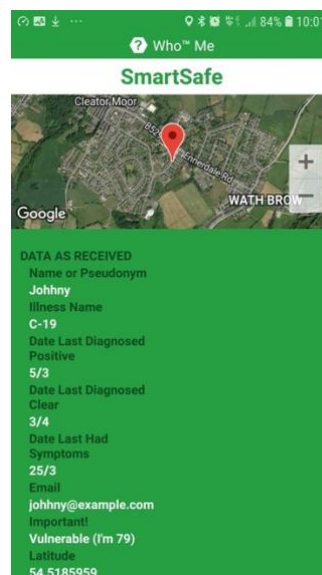


5. View individual screens

Tap on a result in the Discovery page to view an individual's modal page.

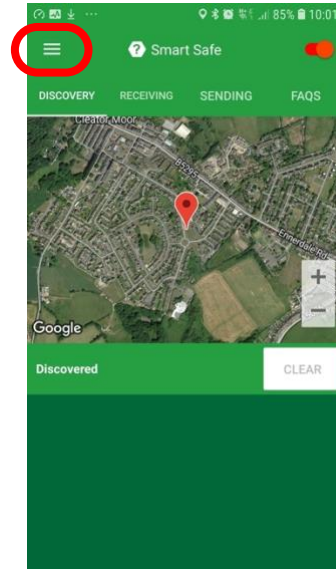
Here you will be able to:

6a. Change settings

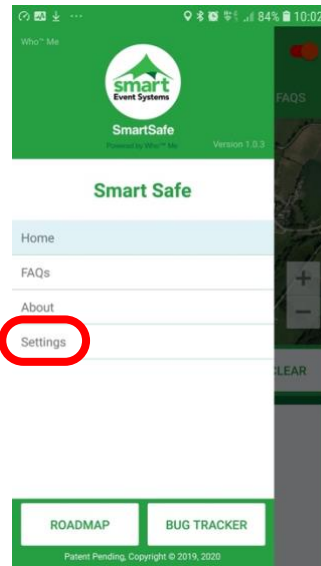
Should you wish to change any settings, simply click the three lined icon button, located on the top left-hand corner of the app.



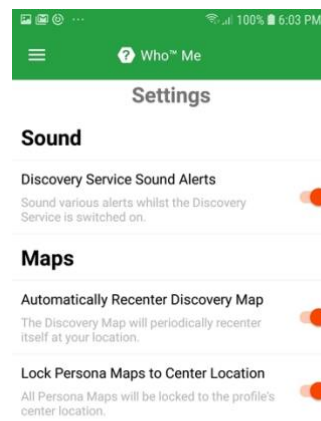
6b. Another menu bar will appear on the left-hand side, select the settings option.

- Broadcast receivers

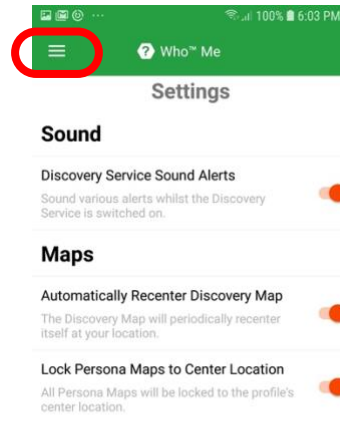


6c. This will bring you to the settings page.
